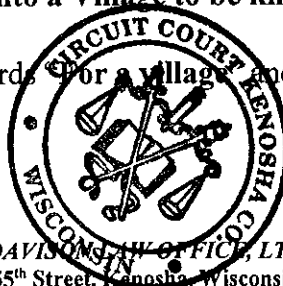
WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Administration issued its Determination on January 9, 2015, that the proposed incorporation of a portion of lands comprising the Town of Somers is in the public interest, and that an Incorporation Referendum be held; and such Determination having been filed with this Court, and the Court now being satisfied that all statutory requirements have been complied with which are prerequisite to this Court's ordering an Incorporation Referendum; now then, on the basis of all papers previously filed in this matter, all matters presented in Court this date, and the Court being otherwise duly advised in the premises.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that a Referendum shall be held on April 7, 2015, at the following locations:

Somers Town Hall  
7511 12<sup>th</sup> Street  
Somers, WI 53171

UW-Parkside Sports & Recreation Center  
County Trunk Highways "E" and "JR"

The Referendum shall be conducted in the same manner as an Annexation Referendum under the provisions of §66.0217(7), Wis. Stats., insofar as applicable, except that the ballot shall contain the following Referendum question: "Should a portion of lands in the Town of Somers be incorporated into a Village to be known as the Village of Somers?" The ballot shall thereafter contain the words "For a village" and "Against a village."

The polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. pursuant to the provisions of §6.78(2), Wis. Stats.; but that any elector waiting his or her turn to vote, whether within the polling booth or in line outside the booth at the time the polls officially close, shall be permitted to vote. Only those electors residing within the boundaries of the proposed Village shall be entitled to cast a referendum ballot.

The following persons are named as the Inspectors of Election at the above named polling locations, and shall promptly make a return to this Court of the results of such Referendum. Persons named as alternative Inspectors of Election, shall perform such duties only in the event that one of the Inspectors named is incapable, unwilling or cannot perform such duties.

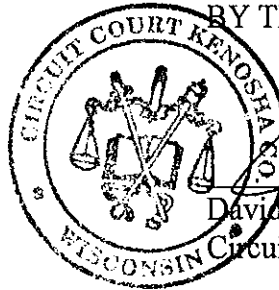
