

ORDINANCE NO. 17- 001

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 7.09
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF SOMERS
RELATING TO ADOPTION OF STATE MOTOR VEHICLE CODE
AND RELATED LAWS

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Somers, Kenosha County,
Wisconsin, hereby repeals and recreates Section 7.09 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of
Somers relating to adoption of state motor vehicle code and related laws to read as follows:

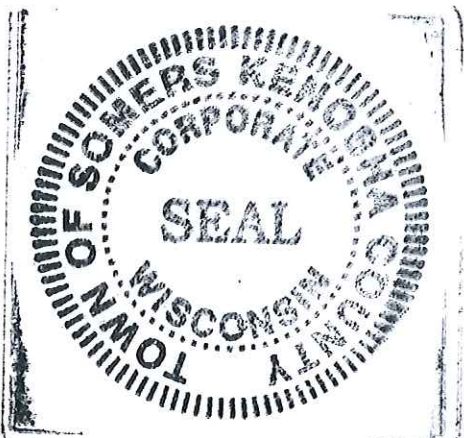
7.09 STATE LAWS ADOPTED.

(a) **Purpose.** The following Chapters of the Wisconsin Statutes are adopted in order
to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, streets, and alleys of the State of
Wisconsin.

(b) **State Traffic Forfeitures Laws Adopted.** Except as otherwise specifically
provided in this Chapter, all provisions of Chapter 340 to 348 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Section
110.075 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and TRANS 305 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, together with
any administrative rules promulgated by the Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles,
State of Wisconsin, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic for which the
penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, are hereby
adopted and made a part of this Chapter.

(c) **Other Laws Adopted.** The remaining provisions of Chapters 340 to 348, Wis.
Stats., and Section 941.01(1), Wis. Stats., relating to the negligent operation of a vehicle and Section
66.95, Wis. Stats., relating to unlocked vehicles/keys left in vehicle, are hereby adopted by reference.
