Thank you for your interest in the Somers Fire and Rescue Department. Those serving as firefighters and EMTs on our department gain much satisfaction in serving the community and also valuable experience that can lead to career opportunities down the road within our department, other departments and jobs in hospitals and on private ambulance services.

As you prepare to fill out the enclosed application, I ask that you first give serious thought about the step you are taking. While the fire service is a noble pursuit, it is a job that of course has to be taken seriously and professionally.

There will also be many time demands and several conditions that you and your family need to be aware of from the onset. Those include:

- You will be serving as a paid-on-call member. That means pay will fluctuate based on the number of calls received, which of course is unpredictable, and how often you respond to those. In short, this is not a job that can be counted on as part of a regular family or personal budget.
- You will be required to take part in a recruit training program that entails several hours a week. In addition, if you don't have required state certifications, you will be required to take courses through Gateway Technical College.
- Once recruit training is complete, you will be required to serve 60 hours each month on shifts. Those
  shifts can be scheduled around your school, job and family requirements and during the daytime,
  nights and weekends. Also, please note that the shifts are not paid, unless a call comes in when an
  hourly rate goes into effect for the duration of the call. Opportunities for paid part-time shifts are
  available once required monthly hours are scheduled.
- Emergency calls can go past when shifts are scheduled to conclude. In addition, for major calls the department can request members to respond when not on shift.
- There are also required monthly trainings and a department meeting and occasional special additional duties, such as school visits, fundraisers and other community events.
- Most importantly, firefighters and EMTs can face extremely stressful and traumatic situations that can put heavy physical and mental strain on the individual.

If you feel that Somers Fire Department is for you, fill out the application and turn in copies of all state certifications/licenses that pertain to Fire and EMS. A copy of a driver's license will also be needed. We will then notify you when to pick up an informational packet that will inform you of dates and times of the application process. If you have any questions, I encourage you to stop by our stations and meet with our members and officers; they are more than happy to do that.
